**We Do Business in Accordance With the Federal Fair
Housing Law**

(The Fair Housing Amendments Act of 1988)

It is unlawful to discriminate based on familial status. Landlords may not unlawfully refuse housing to families with minor children under the age of 18 or pregnant women; or have difference in treatment for families with minor children, like higher security deposits, stricter rules, or limiting them to certain units in a property.
